

### Tips for Writing an Effective Scholarship Essay

Remember that a scholarship essay is a persuasive document

- Write in your own voice

Needs improvement: From all of these experiences, I came to a realization that being a dentist means being an imperative leader, an indispensable team player, and someone with refined dexterity skills.

Better: Leading a dental practice requires coordination among many professionals, and my experience as president of UH Students for Change has demonstrated my success in working with a team of my peers.

### Tips for Writing an Effective Scholarship Essay

- Respond directly to the essay prompt

Prompt: Identify how receiving this scholarship would help further your educational goals.

Somewhere in the response: As a recipient of this scholarship, the financial difficulty that I currently face would be lessened, allowing me to work only my one part-time tutoring job and to dedicate the time I currently spend working in food service to studying. During my senior year, that would enable me to complete an internship offered through my department's "Cougars at Work" program, an opportunity that would not otherwise be available to me.

### Tips for Writing an Effective Scholarship Essay

- Be specific

Needs improvement: My internship helped me understand the power of serving others.

Better: Through working directly with wonderful researchers in the dynamic field of biotechnology, I see now that this field has the wonderful potential not only to be on the cutting edge of technological innovation, but also to aid many patients who previously would not have had access to such resources.

- But be concise

Best: Through working directly with researchers in biotechnology, I now understand the field's potential not only to be on the cutting edge of technological innovation, but also to aid many patients in need.

### Tips for Writing an Effective Scholarship Essay

- Talk about your characteristics and qualifications by referencing specific examples

Needs improvement: To succeed academically you must work hard, and I am well-qualified based on my work ethic.

Better: Working as a math tutor while simultaneously taking 18 hours and receiving a 3.5 GPA last semester was a challenge, but my planning and time management skills assured my success. In addition to using the work as a way to earn money, I could also brush up on my skills for my classes, and I knew that I would also have time to study when I wasn't working with students.

### Tips for Writing an Effective Scholarship Essay

- Tailor your essay to the organization granting the scholarship

From the UH Alumni Association website: “The UH Alumni Association is a global community of alumni and friends committed to and sharing pride in the growth and support of the University of Houston as a premier institution.”

Example of tailoring an essay: Receiving this scholarship would enable me to use my interest in studying abroad to further my studies in international business while demonstrating the global reach of UH as a premier academic institution.

### Tips for Writing an Effective Scholarship Essay

- Revise multiple times
  - Start well in advance of the due date
  - Complete a draft and put it aside
  - Review the draft to make improvements
  - Have others review it
    - Visit the UH Writing Center
  - Proofread for errors of grammar and punctuation
