


FLEX-VAL Validation

1. Using T2 supported Chrome web browser Go to following URL

3. Connect the Honeywell 7580 QR Code scanner through any available USB port on the computer (no driver download is required)



- Once logged in make sure you select the external scanner to scan the QR code on the validation ticket



Point the scanner over the barcode and press the button on the scanner.

- Position the QR Code in front of the scanner once you hear the peep you will see a message that the discount has successfully applied.

Point the scanner over the barcode and press the button on the scanner.

6. You can use the manual ticket entry if scanner is not available. Using the ticket number on the validation ticket: **2502001138**



7. Make sure you select Enter Manually option then enter the ticket number in the fields below. Using the first two digits as the facility field, the second two digits in the Lane number field and the last 6 digits in the ticket number filed.



9. The third option if you want to use mobile phone or tablet (Android or iPhone), using the same method. Using the web browser on your phone or iPad select internal Camera option. Place the QR Code on the ticket in front of the camera.



Enable (or Disable) Kiosk Mode

T2 Flex-Val Mobile kiosk mode limits its use to just selecting a validation type and selecting the barcode input method (camera, scanner, or manual), and validating Tickets. No other functions, such as viewing invoices or managing users, are available while the app is in kiosk mode.


Note:

The first time you put a device into kiosk mode, you set up a local password which will be what you use to enable and disable kiosk mode on the device in the future.

1. Enable kiosk mode:

- a. In the user menu, select Enable Kiosk Mode.


The user menu shows all the available options for the person who's logged in.



The first time you enable kiosk mode, the app prompts for a password. This is what you'll use to enable and disable kiosk mode on this device in the future. This password is only good on this device. Each device gets its own.

- b. Enter the kiosk mode password for the device, being sure to follow appropriate guidelines for password security.
- c. Click [Enter].


The app is now in kiosk mode



The only actions possible will be selecting the validation type and the barcode input method, and validating tickets, of course. In the user menu, only one option is now available: Disable Kiosk Mode.

2. Disable kiosk mode:


a. In the user menu, select Disable Kiosk Mode.



A password prompt displays.

b. Enter the kiosk password you created earlier, and click [Enter].

The app is no longer in kiosk mode.



Once more, the user menu shows all options for the person who has logged in.
