ROGER W. ANDERSON, DrPH, FASHP

Dr. Roger W. Anderson received his undergraduate pharmacy degree from Ferris State University in 1964. He obtained a M.S. in Hospital Pharmacy from The Ohio State University in 1968 and completed an accredited Residency in Hospital Pharmacy at Grant Hospital in Columbus, Ohio in 1967. He earned a Doctorate in Public Health (Dr. P.H.) from the University of Texas in 1997.



He served as Assistant Director of Pharmacy at the Ohio State University Hospitals (1967-69), Director of Pharmacy and Central Supply at Grant Hospital (1969-73), and Vice President for Operations at Pharmacy Systems. In 1978, he began his 26-year tenure with M.D. Anderson Cancer Center of Houston serving as Vice President and Head of the Division of Pharmacy. After his successful tenure at M.D. Anderson Cancer Center, Dr. Anderson served in senior executive roles with Medco Health Solutions and then US Oncology (now McKesson Specialty Health) before retiring.

Highlights of his accomplishments include: internationally renowned as a trailblazer in health-system pharmacy leadership; advanced the pharmacy practice model at one of the nation's top cancer centers — University of Texas-MD Anderson Cancer Center; authored 60+ publications; served as ASHP President; and received the ASHP Harvey A.K. Whitney Award.

Joshua A. Blackwell, PharmD, MS, MBA, FASHP, FTSHP, BCSCP

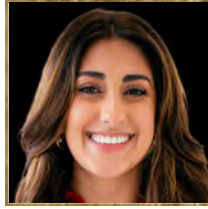

A nationally recognized pharmacy leader, Dr. Blackwell has dedicated his career to advancing ambulatory care, pharmacy leadership development, practice innovation, and advocacy. He has held numerous leadership roles within ASHP, TSHP, and national pharmacy organizations, while also mentoring future pharmacy leaders through residency training, teaching, and professional development.

As Co-Founder of Pharmacist Initiative Leaders (PILs) Enterprises, Dr. Blackwell has coached and supported aspiring and established pharmacy leaders across the country, helping individuals successfully obtain residency and fellowship positions while continuing to mentor them at every stage of their professional and personal journeys. His work has focused on expanding patient access to care, advancing diversity and inclusion initiatives, strengthening health-system pharmacy practice, and elevating the role of pharmacists across healthcare. Dr. Blackwell is honored as the 2026 recipient of the Roger W. Anderson Leadership Award in recognition of his impactful leadership, service to the profession, and commitment to developing future generations of pharmacy leaders.

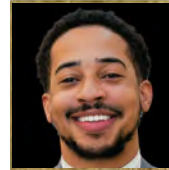

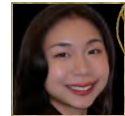
