

UHCOP Immunization & Personal Records Checklist

- Driver's License**
- Intern License** – will get once enrolled in classes
- Proof of Health Insurance:** students may choose to purchase health insurance from any provider but it must meet or exceed the coverage by UH student health insurance. You **must** have health insurance coverage by the first day of school.

- COVID-19 Vaccine** – This is not a requirement of UH College of Pharmacy, however site may require this vaccine
- Hepatitis B Titer* or Hep. B vaccination series (3) shots.** If you have not received Hepatitis B vaccination in the past, please start the series now to complete by the deadline.
- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) Titer* or MMR vaccination series (2) shots.**
- Varicella Titer* or Varicella vaccination series (2) shots.** Show of chickenpox occurrence does not provide exemption for above!
- Tdap (Tetanus-diphtheria-acellular pertussis vaccine) (Big T, little d, little a, little p) – Tdap is required for all incoming students.** If you have gotten a Tdap vaccine once in your life, you do not have to get another one. Instead you will need to get a TD (Tetanus-Diphtheria) booster. Tdap is valid for 10 years, after that students will need to get a TD booster.
- Influenza-** Flu shot to be received on an annual basis.
- TB Test: There are three tests which can satisfy this requirement. TB test must be administered between July 1 – August 5, 2026**
 1. **TB Skin Test:** documentation must include the date the TB test was administered and the date the TB test was read and the results of the TB test.
 2. **Chest X-Ray:** students who are aware that they get a false positive TB skin test can get a chest x-ray. NOTE: once you get a chest x-ray you will need to annual get a chest x-ray or a QFT (QuantiFERON) test.
 3. **QFT (QuantiFERON) TB Gold test:** special populations who have traveled internationally and/or those of you who are aware that you may get a false positive TB skin test which would require a chest xray, have the option of a QFT (QuantiFERON) – TB Gold test.

***Titer:** if you receive a titer and it is negative or equivocal (after consulting with your health provider) you will need to restart the series. All series need to be completed by the deadlines provided below.

Deadline	Requirement
Augusts 24 th , 2026	Driver's License
Augusts 24 th , 2026	Health Insurance – Summer, Fall, Spring (front and back of card)
January 31 st , 2027	Intern License
January 31 st , 2027	Hepatitis B vaccination series (3) or acceptable proof of immunity (i.e. titers)
Augusts 24 th , 2026	MMR Vaccination or acceptable proof of immunity (2 MMR; i.e. titers)
Augusts 24 th , 2026	Tetanus/diphtheria/acellular pertussis (Tdap) – once
Augusts 24 th , 2026	Td – Tetanus diphtheria – booster every 10 years
October 15, 2026	Influenza vaccine due annually in fall semester when vaccine is available.
Tuberculosis Test Results (most current test results from July 1st -Aug. 5th, 2026) – Choose one of the following	
Augusts 24 th , 2026	Negative Tuberculosis Skin Test (PPD)
Augusts 24 th , 2026	Negative Tuberculosis Test - Chest X-Ray
Augusts 24 th , 2026	Negative Tuberculosis Test - Blood Test (QuantiFERON [®] or QFT)
Varicella Test Results – Choose one or more of the following	
Augusts 24 th , 2026	Varicella (chicken pox) Immunity – 2 vaccinations
Augusts 24 th , 2026	Varicella (chicken pox) Immunity – Varicella Titer
