UHCOP PHARM.D. TUTORING PROGRAM

Overview

The College of Pharmacy and Office of Student Services provides tutoring services to support Pharm.D. students. Tutors are accessible on an “as-needed” basis. At the start of the semester, students will receive a list with the tutors’ contact information and their tutoring topics for the semester. We also recommend reaching out to a faculty member as needed.

Who are the tutors?

Tutors are current Pharm.D. students.

Forms and Methods of Tutoring

Individual Tutoring is one-on-one with tutors, while Drop-In Tutoring is available once a week from 12 pm to 1 pm in a reserved study room. Tutoring sessions can be conducted Face to Face or via Facetime or other videochat program, Web or phone.

How should I prepare for a tutoring session?

Students are expected to arrive/log-in to their session on time, prepared and ready to learn in order to make the most of the session. It is recommended to prepare questions and specific areas to review.

How to meet with a tutor?

Email the tutor directly. Be sure to identify the specific areas in which help is needed so that the best tutor can be chosen and the tutor can be better prepared.
