

CUB CAMP COUNSELOR 2019

Thank you for your interest in being a part of the Cub Camp family. We appreciate the time you're taking to contribute to our organization's success, and the success of the first year experience. Being a Cub Camp Counselor has the potential to be one of the most rewarding and unforgettable experiences in your college career. You will be able to make a unique impact on the freshman class, develop leadership skills, and gain friendships. This is a freshman's first tradition, and your first step towards changing the lives of the UH Class of 2023!

The primary role of a Camp Counselor is to serve as a support system for freshmen and help them transition into college life. While at camp, freshmen are divided into 4 different camps. Counselors are assigned to each camp and lead freshmen in small discussion groups (DG) along with their Counselor partner. They continue to connect with freshmen from their DG after camp by maintaining connections throughout the first year.

Counselor Requirements:

- Be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours as an undergraduate student at the University of Houston for the Spring 2019, and Fall 2019 semesters. Students graduating in the Spring or Summer of 2019 are not eligible for hire.
- Students who are Resident Assistants in Student Housing and Residential Life are not eligible for hire, as mandatory RA training dates overlap with Cub Camp.
- Have at least a 2.25 overall (cumulative) grade point average.
- Have at least one full semester of experience at the University of Houston.
- Be in good academic standing with the University of Houston
- Fulfill all responsibilities as deemed necessary by the Executive Team and Co-Chairs, including but not limited to:
 - Attend all mandatory staff functions
 - Along with a DG partner, mentor a small group of freshman at Cub Camp
 - Contribute to developing camp branding, including but not limited to: Camp Theme, Namesake incorporation, socials, and other camp planning
 - Attend camp meetings and workdays for the purpose of camp planning and preparation
 - Uphold the Cub Camp Mission and Values

- Serve as an ambassador of the University of Houston
- Attend all Cub Camp functions as deemed necessary by the Executive Team and Co-Chairs
- Other duties as assigned
