

**Global Citizens Credential
COVID-19 Temporary Accommodations**

UH Global will implement the following accommodations until further notice. Please refer to the website for more information about points and documentation required for the activities within the below categories.

Program Requirements:

- **Global Courses:** No change. Students can continue to earn points for any approved global course regardless of the method of delivery (online classes included) since points are given based on credits earned and final grade in the course. However, for courses taken pass/fail during this period, only courses with a passing grade will be accepted.
- **Learning Abroad:** Since UH learning abroad programs were cancelled during the spring 2020 and summer 2020 semesters and because students are not able to go abroad during their final semester, students graduating in summer 2020 or fall 2020 can earn points for any cancelled learning abroad trip. If UH learning abroad programs are cancelled for fall 2020 as well, this would be extended for spring 2021 graduates. Students must submit written documentation that shows they were confirmed for the trip and proof of cancellation.
- **Language Proficiency:** No change. Students can continue to earn points for any approved language course regardless of the method of delivery (online classes included) since points are given based on credits earned and final grade in the course. However, for courses taken pass/fail during this period, only courses with a passing grade will be accepted. For those who are already fluent in another language, students can meet with professors virtually for a language proficiency assessment or complete an online foreign language placement exam offered by UH Testing Services.
- **Global Scholarly Work:** For research, students may earn points for research that is performed at home with remote support from a professor. In lieu of Global Scholarly Work events, students may earn points for completing any of the following online activities and submitting a one page reflection paper of the activity: Attending an online lecture, webinar, or academic lecture on a global topic, completing a diversity training, or participating in a similar online activity that is academic in nature and has a multicultural or global focus.
- **Intercultural Activities:** For international leadership activities (internships, volunteer, and student organization leadership), students may earn points for a leadership role performed in an online capacity with written documentation. In lieu of Intercultural activities/events, students may earn points for completing any of the following online activities and submitting a one page reflection paper of the activity: Watching a foreign film or online cultural performance, reading a novel or nonfiction book by a foreign author or on a global or multicultural topic, engaging in an online cultural activity or a similar activity that allows the student to learn about another culture.

Capstone: If in-person Capstone is not possible, it will be offered online and virtual attendance will be taken. UH Global will reach out to those who meet requirements to register.
