



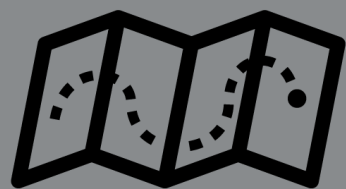
# What is UHin4?

The UHin4 Four-Year Graduation Plan helps incoming freshmen graduate within 4 years. Students in the program receive the following benefits



## Priority Enrollment

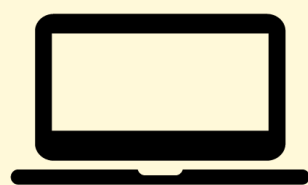
Allows students to enroll in classes before registration opens to the campus community.



## Academic Maps

Provide a guided pathway toward 4 year (or less) degree completion.

## Course Availability



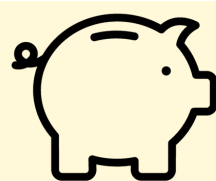

## Peer Assistant Leaders (PALs)



Are upperclassmen in UHin4 who guide students on their personal journey toward four-year completion.

## Fixed Rate Tuition Plan



The fixed rate allows students and families to plan for a fixed cost of tuition for four years. Please note: The Fixed Rate Tuition Plan is based on 15 credit hours per semester. Students are not automatically placed into the Fixed Rate Tuition Plan.
