## 4 STEPS TO ENROLL IN COURSES WITH 1 CLICK AT ORIENTATION



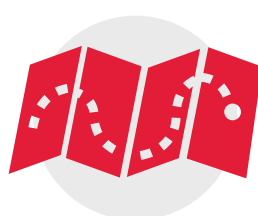
### REVIEW ACADEMIC TERMS

The 4 academic terms listed below will help you prepare for course enrollment at orientation.



### VIEW THE COURSE SCHEDULE

The course schedule allows you to search for and get details about available courses for each term. You can learn about the course schedule [here](#).



### REVIEW YOUR ACADEMIC MAP

UHin4 students have access to an academic map that lists required courses and provides a guided pathway toward 4-year degree completion.



### ADD COURSES TO YOUR SHOPPING CART

Add courses to your shopping cart based on your Academic Map before orientation. This will allow you to quickly enroll in courses at orientation with just 1 click. View the steps to add courses to your shopping cart [here](#).

**PRO TIP:** Follow the steps above to build your schedule by orientation so you can enroll with one click. You may add additional courses as a backup plan.



## 4 ACADEMIC TERMS TO KNOW BEFORE ORIENTATION

### ACADEMIC ADVISOR

Helps students select required courses for degree completion

### CREDIT HOUR

Represents 1 hour of class time per week

### MWF, TU/TH

MWF refers to Monday, Wednesday, and Friday courses. TU/TH refers to Tuesday and Thursday courses

### CORE CURRICULUM

The set of classes (totaling 60 credit hours) that all students must take in order to complete a bachelor's degree program

## FOUR-YEAR GRADUATION PLAN



### COURSE AVAILABILITY

We will assist you with course enrollment needed for 4 year graduation if a required course is full



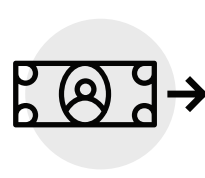
### PRIORITY ENROLLMENT

Access to join the Fixed Rate Tuition Plan

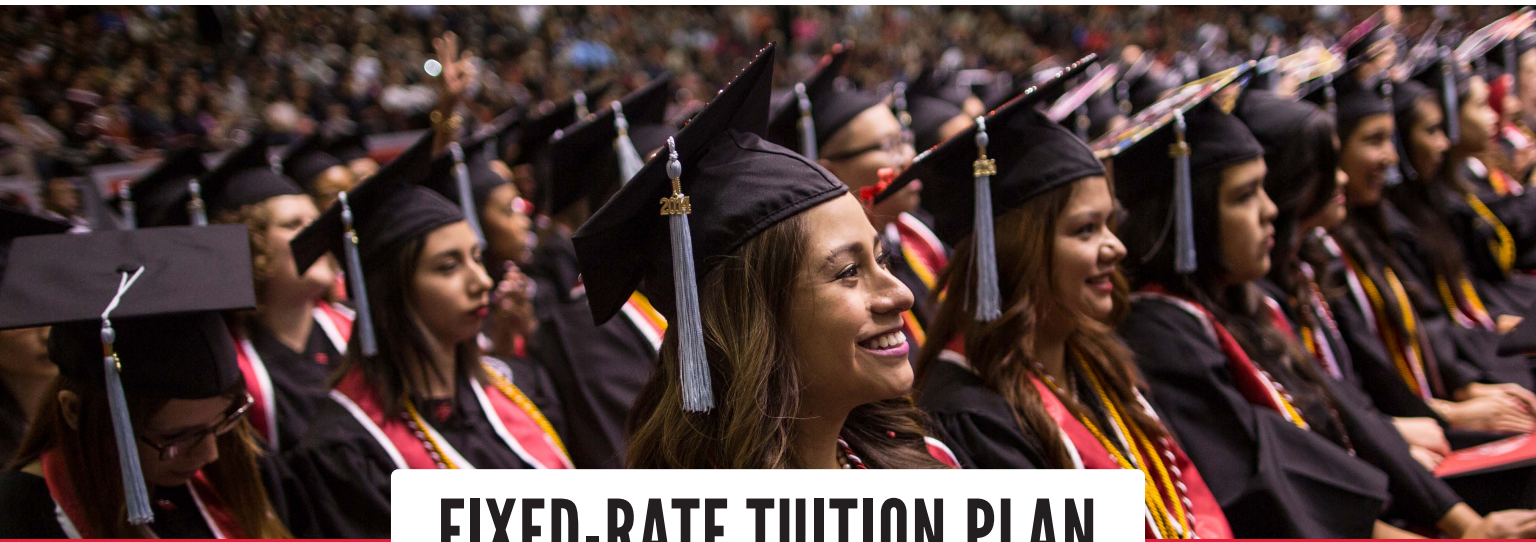


### PEER ASSISTANT LEADERS(PALS)

An upperclassman in UHin4(PAL) will guide you on your personal journey toward four-year completion



Please note that if you have AP/dual credit, you may use that credit to remain on track for four year graduation. However, you must still enroll in 15 credit hours your first semester. Your academic advisor will help you determine what courses you have credit for and what courses you still need to enroll in.



## FIXED-RATE TUITION PLAN

The Fixed Rate Tuition Plan is an optional program that locks in your tuition for four years, eliminating future tuition increases. The Fixed Rate Tuition Plan includes:



A fixed tuition rate based on 15 credit hours per semester and on your major.



Discounted summer courses



Fall and spring mini sessions for no additional cost.

Students who do not participate in the **Fixed Rate Tuition Plan** will pay the variable tuition rate. The variable rate varies by the number of credit hours students enroll in and it changes every year.
