*Core Curriculum

**Business Administration and Management Field of Study (SCM majors are required to make a C+ or higher in SCM 3301, and a grade of C or higher in STAT 3331 as a prerequisite for 4000-level SCM courses.)

>3000-4000 level business courses, except for MARK 3337, ENTR 3310 and ENTR 3312, are not open to non-business majors unless required for their major, a business minor or special program; these students should take core courses instead. Students are not eligible to change their major to business if they do not meet the requirements by the semester they complete 45 credit hours.

Students should meet with their academic advisor to formulate their own plan.
