Professional Development:

Two teachers completed the 3-year program and are TSR certified

- \$2,000 in incentive pay and \$5,000 in classroom materials and curriculum
- A 5th preschool teacher joined the program this fall
- All 5 preschool classrooms have a teacher trained in TSR





New child care subsidies for:

- Active duty or deployed service members that are unable to obtain child care on a military installation
- Parents that meet Workforce Solutions family income guidelines
- Student parents who are Pell Grant eligible







Increase in Resources:

Child Care Access Means Parents In School (CCAMPIS)

- 2014-2018: \$375,000 annually (\$1.5M)
- 2018-2022: \$558,998 annually (\$2.2M)



Texas Rising Star (November 2018)

• Coaching, training, materials, stipends, scholarships

Student Employment: Increased starting salary from \$7.25 to \$8.00



Challenges

CAS External Review Finding:

"Every group we met with mentioned the outdated facilities as well as the need to house the CLC program in one central location with newer facilities. This will help with the current issues reported as well as easing the double drop-offs for some parents and providing a cohesive environment for all staff where they each feel connected. It would also help with the Emergency Preparedness plan, eliminating the need for the restroom being the only safe space for the children to shelter in place in the event of an emergency."
