Technology continues to evolve. Especially in higher education. To continue to expand our vision and maintain an efficient and proactive information technology environment that provides seamless support and tier one customer service that elevates staff productivity, and services.

DSAES IT Services currently has **10 full-time** and **4 student staff members**. Most of our budget is dedicated to support and replace computers and pay salaries and student wages. There is very little funding to support training and continued development.

In Spring 2019, as part of External Review recommendations, we were charged with providing our staff with more professional development and certification opportunities for both our student and full-time staff.

This funding would allow our staff to travel to conferences, receive specific technology training related to Higher Education systems, and establish a certification program for our student staff.
