The UH Children's Learning Centers (CLC) is housed in two different locations: Wheeler and Cameron.

The CLC Wheeler location, across from the UH Police Station, was opened in 1975 in temporary modular buildings. These are the same buildings we continue to operate from today.



Since 1975, we have made many playground enhancements, in part, with the support of SFAC funding. However, some of the areas are in need of repair. The synthetic grass turf was installed in 2012 to meet the playground safety standards around elevated playground equipment from which children could fall. Overtime, the underfill in 3 playground areas has shifted/moved and made the surface uneven. We are asking for \$22,600.00 to repair these surfaces.



The CLC Cameron location is in the Isabel C. Cameron building. This steel-framed, masonry constructed facility was originally built in 1970.



In 2010, CLC made renovations to the former UH Lab School to accommodate 2 infant and 3 toddler classrooms, as well as office and meeting/work rooms. Since this time, the interior and playground exterior walls are beginning to show age and cracks. We are requesting \$15,000.00 to repair these wall surfaces.
