FY2023 One-Time Request #2 – Digital Events Chair and Programming

The Student Program Board is submitting a second FY2023 One-Time Request to the Student Fees Advisory Committee for an additional SPB position, Digital Events Chair, and funding for this chair to be able to program.

SPB is requesting \$16,370.32 to support gaming related programming for the Spring semester of FY23. By doing so, SPB will reach additional students in our community who don't attend traditional programs and activities. Student Centers had a grand opening for CoogArcade on February 1st, 2022. Since that time, players have logged over 1,500 hours illustrating how the gaming community on UH's campus has been rapidly growing. A Digital Events Chair would be able to assess the needs of the community and create relevant digital programming. The Digital Events chair would be paid at \$8/per hour, reflecting the pay of existing SPB chairs, and would be needed for the remainder of the Spring Semester, January 1st, 2023, to April 30th, 2023.

In addition to another position, the Digital Events chair would also need funding to host programming for the student body. Students showed their interested into digital events by attending the first ever Cougar Con with over 1,100 attendees. Cougar Con was a comic book and anime convention themed event catered to gamers of all kinds, exclusive run by UH registered student organizations. Coog eSports was a leading organization, and we look forward to collaborating and growing and this event. Due to its attendance, it has come with high demand to expand and host again. Additionally, this chair would help host competitions and tournaments both online and in person in the Student Centers. Currently, CoogArcade hosts both in person and online intramural tournaments with an average attendance of 50-100 students per event. SPB wants to continue investing in these already successful endeavors and plans to expand.
