FY24 One-Time Request

The Metropolitan Volunteer Program's (MVP) FY24 One-Time request is as follows:

1. \$6,525.00 for Be The MVP

MVP believes that this request will allow us to more effectively meet the needs of the city of Houston and the Third Ward community. If approved, these funds will provide students with the opportunity to engage with MVP at the beginning of the year, and how to create positive, sustainable change in our community.

FY23 One-Time Request – Be The MVP

MVP hosted Be the MVP for the second time this past August 2022, an event to connect with students at the University of Houston through different activities established by our chairs on the first day of classes. We almost doubled our attendance from the previous year, increasing from 266 attendees to 429 attendees. Students were able to stay cool while completing service projects thanks to tents, enjoy food while they worked, and music provided by a DJ. These features attracted greater attendance, which led to an increased quantity of service projects that were able to be completed. Be The MVP provides an avenue for us to create a first impression of our organization and our impact in the community during Weeks of Welcome. Through this event, we are not only able to introduce ourselves to incoming students, but also connect students to opportunities for service in our community and the campus. This year, we promoted nearly a dozen volunteering events taking place during the first few weeks of school. This led to increased turnout at our first three MVP committee events, the Mega Houston Adoption event, Project CURE, Nora's Home Sunflower Sacks, all of which promoted positive change in the greater Houston area.

We hope Be The MVP will provide an opportunity for students to learn more about our four different service committees (Hunger & Homelessness, Children & Education, Health & Wellness, and Environment & Sustainability) and the work we have previously done with our different community partners. This event is made to encourage UH students to be involved in the community and establish a direct line of communication between students and the organization's board members. We plan to establish Be The MVP as a signature event that we would like to continue to host during Weeks of Welcome.
