Funding Request: \$10,600 for Harm Reduction training and marketing/promo materials

Leadership Ambassadors

Council members provide valuable insight to DOS staff regarding policies, programs, and procedures seeking to identify barriers and address them with campus stakeholders.

Funding Request: \$5,300 for trainings, food, merch, marketing, and programming.

Friends of DOS Faculty/Staff/Student Recognition Program

Goal: This awards program and dinner event is to celebrate faculty, staff & students that have supported student success by collaborating with DOS.

Funding Request: \$5,300 for food and decorations.

Finish Line Club

Goal: This initiative is to offer programming for students transitioning back to campus after suspension or medical withdrawal.

Funding Request: \$2,650 for food and awards for the event.

Commuter Student Services

Goal: This initiative is to offer programming and engagement opportunities toward commuter students to strengthen their sense of belonging to UH.

Funding Request: \$5,300 for food and programming expenses.

Lunch & Learn Series

Goal: To have engaging conversations with UH students about topics and resources related to helping students succeed. A total of six will be held each academic year.

Funding Request: \$3,710 for food.

AD Bruce Free Lunch

Goal: This initiative is to offer UH students free lunch twice an academic year in partnership with the AD Brice Religion Center.

Funding Request: \$2,120 for food and promotional materials.

Commuter Ambassador Program

Goal: These student leaders aid in host events, social media campaigns, table at resource fairs, and collaborate with other departments and student organizations to engage and support commuter students.

Funding Request: \$5,300 for food, marketing, programming, and retreats.

Student Outreach & Support

Goal: SOS provides comprehensive assistance and guidance to students facing personal, academic, or emotional challenges. The SOS team helps students overcome obstacles, foster well-being, and contributes to a positive and successful college experience.

Funding Request: \$2,120 for food, programming, promotion, and trainings.
