Petitioner(s): Aniyah Hubbard

Respondent(s): Joshua Sambrano and Lundan Sherrod

The following allegations were filed March 3, 2026, 10:44 AM:

- **Article 5, Clause 9:** "No candidate shall assist a voter in the use of an online voting system other than by providing instructions on how to access the online ballot page. Once the potential voter has received instructions and opened the online ballot, candidates shall not be involved further in the individual's voting process."
- **Article 4, Section 4, Clause 7:** "No candidate or campaign staff member shall request proof that an individual voted for a candidate that they claim to have voted for."

Decision [03/05/26]: Petitioner's complaint **DOES NOT HAVE MERIT** regarding a violation of the Election Code.

Conclusion: While the report alleges that the candidate physically interacted with another student's device during the voting process, the provided visual evidence is insufficient to establish a definitive violation. The image provided (IMG_9782.jpg) is low-resolution and taken from a distance, making it impossible to confirm that the candidate was navigating a ballot or selecting voting options on the device.

Sanction: None.
