Petitioner(s): Madelyn Stuart

Respondent(s): Tav Cockrell and Ian Kariuki

The following allegations were filed March 4, 2026, 3:21 PM:

- **Article 4, Section 2, Clause 4:** "No candidate may campaign door-to-door in residence halls or take any other action that violates the University of Houston Student Housing & Residential Life Policy."
- **University Housing & CSI Policy:** "Materials may not be posted in any unauthorized location, including doors, light posts, trees, building windows, car windshields, etc.; or over previously posted materials."

Decision [03/06/26]: Petitioner's complaint **DOES NOT HAVE MERIT.**

Conclusion: This complaint constitutes a **double jeopardy** situation. The allegations regarding the placement of promotional flyers on car windshields in Zone B have already been adjudicated under **Complaint #22**. While the petitioner claims these occurred at different times, they originate from the same course of conduct already sanctioned. Furthermore, the Judiciary rules that this specific instance does not constitute a new, separate violation of University policy beyond what was already addressed in the previous ruling. Please refer to **Violation #22** for full details on the initial merit ruling and associated sanctions.


