The Campus Safety Task Force

By the authority vested in me as the President by the Constitution and the Bylaws of the University of Houston Student Government Association, and consistent with Title III, Article 1, Section 8, Clause 1 of the Bylaws, I hereby order the following:

Section 1. Purpose.

In an individual survey of 79 students, 47% of students do not feel safe walking on-campus at night.

The same survey revealed 43% of students have not attended an event/meeting on-campus due to safety concerns related to how late it ended.

Campus security is a major concern for students at the University of Houston and the Student Government Association must do everything in its power to advocate for students and assist in efforts to provide as safe an environment as possible.

Section 2. Action.

- (A) The Student Government will form a task-force to address student safety on campus;
- (B) This task-force is created upon this executive order's announcement to the public;
- (C) The Vice-President of the Student Government will begin soliciting applications for this task force upon the announcement of this executive order to the public;
- (D) This task-force meet at least once per month, beginning in the month following its creation;
- (E) The duties of the Campus Safety Task-Force include, but are not limited to:
 - 1. Researching strategies and methods to improve campus safety;
 - 2. Working in collaboration with the University and Student Government Administrations to address campus safety;
 - 3. Raise awareness of resources on campus pertaining to safety; and
 - 4. Spur awareness and access to current services on campus.
- (F) All students will be allowed to apply to this task-force;
- (G) The Vice President of the Student Government Association serve as the chair for this task-force.
