Whereas, a temporary solution can easily be applied until constitutional changes take effect.

Therefore be it enacted that the 52nd Senate of the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:


Authorize that the Chief Justice shall have the authority to create a temporary court to cover issues not relating to the constitutionality of an issue.

Be it further enacted, that the temporary court must be approved by the President and Speaker of the Senate.

Finally be it enacted, that this this legislation shall expire after the referendum for Ballot Measure 52001 is completed.
