Senate Resolution in Support of University of Houston Satellite Campus Ambassadors

Whereas, University of Houston has satellite campuses in Sugar Land and Northwest Houston currently; and

Whereas, Sugar Land campus currently serves 4,500 students and an additional 2,600 students are expected to be added; and

Whereas, UH has plans for a \$58.5 million expansion project in Katy; and

Whereas, UH is growing and currently experiencing a culture change; and

Whereas, there is a lack of student representation in all current UH satellite campus; and

Whereas, there is a lack of communication between main campus and the satellites campuses,

Therefore, be it resolved by the Senate of the 52nd Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

That, the Student Body President appoints 2 Student Ambassadors for each of the Satellite campus;

And also be it further enacted that, one ambassador will be responsible for getting feedback from the students of the Satellite Campuses and the other ambassador will be responsible for marketing University of Houston events to the students Satellite Campuses;

And also be it further enacted that, both ambassadors will present bi-weekly reports at the University of Houston Student Government Association Senate Meetings.


