**Inclusive Student Resource Accessibility Act**

**Whereas**, finding catered resources such as scholarships, mentorship programs, and career-building opportunities can be difficult for incoming students, especially in a virtual environment;

**Whereas**, a single, formalized resource list or page representative of the diversity of students within the University of Houston is nonexistent or elusive;

**Whereas**, one of the purposes of the Student Government Association is to enhance the quality of the student experience<sup>1</sup>;

**Whereas**, the 57<sup>th</sup> Administration of the UH Student Government Association is committed to the representation of historically underrepresented students;

**Therefore, be it enacted by the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:**

The 'Resources' tab on the UH SGA website serve as a formalized hub for students to find resources appropriate for their respective identities.

**Be it further enacted** the 'Resources' tab will be updated yearly by the Chair of the Student Life Committee or their designee;


