The University of Connecticut School of Social Work, a leader in MSW graduate education in Connecticut and throughout the New England region, is an integral part of the state's flagship land and sea grant Research University. It shares with the other units of the University the pursuit of excellence in teaching, research and scholarship, and a commitment to public service that brings the knowledge of the University to the people of the State and the world. The curriculum of the School of Social Work is a two year, 60 credit masters program that focuses on methods as its primary approach to advanced concentrations. These methods are Administration, Casework, Community Organization, Group Work and Policy and Planning. Applications for a faculty position in Casework are being sought. Faculty duties will include teaching in this method concentration as well as in the foundation and elective curriculum, student advising and field consultation, contribution to scholarship, and service to the School, University and the community. The School will give priority to those candidates who can contribute through research, teaching, and public engagement to the diversity and excellence of the Social Work learning experience.

Qualifications:

- *MSW and five years casework practice with racially diverse/ethnic communities.
- *Doctorate in Social Work or a related field by August 23, 2010; ABD candidates with degree conferred within one year of initial appointment will be considered for an appointment as an Instructor. Equivalent foreign degrees are acceptable.
- *Previous experience in teaching and student supervision is required.
- *Expertise in substance abuse, health, child welfare or mental health is preferred.
- *An established record of scholarship is also preferred.
- *Ability to contribute to Black Studies in Social Work is preferred.

Incumbent may be required to work at the University of Connecticut's main campus located in Storrs, and/or the campuses at Avery Point, Hartford, Stamford, Torrington, Waterbury, and West Hartford.

The anticipated start date is August 23, 2010. Salary and rank will be determined based on experience and qualifications.

Applications will be accepted until the position is filled. Screening will begin immediately.
