**Assistant /Associate Professor of Special Education**

Applicants are invited to apply for an assistant/associate professor nine month, tenure track position in the Department of Special Education. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.

**Qualifications:** Applicants must have earned or anticipate earning a doctorate by August, 2010 in the education of students with mild/moderate disabilities and must have teaching experience with exceptional children in K-12 schools. Preference will be given to applicants with a focus on teaching students with serious emotional disturbance and to applicants committed to preparing teachers for culturally diverse populations with and without disabilities.

**Responsibilities:** The successful candidate will be expected to teach on-campus and online graduate courses, integrate instructional technology, advise students, and supervise field experiences. The successful candidate will be expected to participate in scholarly research and publications, grant proposal writing, community service, and demonstrate excellence in both pre-service and in-service teaching.
