

**Tenure-Track Assistant Professor of Undergraduate Social Work
for the 2011-2012 Academic Year**

Tuskegee University

The Department of Social Work at Tuskegee University invites candidates to apply for a tenure-track position at the assistant professor or associate professor level of undergraduate Social Work beginning August, 2011.

Responsibilities: Primary responsibilities include teaching at the undergraduate social work level. Candidates are expected to teach in all areas across the curriculum with an emphasis on diversity and teaching students how to provide services for marginal as well as highly skilled populations. Additional responsibilities include: student advising, participating in departmental, university-wide, and community activities; participating in BSW curriculum development, and developing a scholarly agenda consistent as it relates to grant writing and publications. Candidates are expected to contribute to the academic mission of the University as reflected in the university's commitment to diversity and global perspectives, which brings Tuskegee to the World and the World to Tuskegee.

Requirements: Candidates must possess a doctorate in social work, a master's degree in social work from a CSWE accredited university (or international equivalent), at least two years of post-master's direct practice experience. ABDs with a definite completion date will be considered. Prior teaching experience in social work or a related field is required; experience in a CSWE accredited social work program (or international equivalent) is preferred.

Candidates should submit: (a) a letter of interest outlining interest in and qualifications for the position, including research interests, teaching areas, and areas of service and/or leadership; (b) a teaching philosophy; (c) a curriculum vitae; (d) a copy of graduate transcripts; (e) three letters of reference which comment on applicant's teaching, scholarship, and/or service/leadership. Finalists must successfully complete the on-campus interview process and teaching demonstration. The position is available August 2011. Review of applications will begin June 2011 and will continue until the position is filled. Submit requested information to Dr. Catherine R.
