The Newman University School of Social Work located in Wichita, Kansas invites applications for a tenure track faculty position at the rank of **Assistant Professor** scheduled to begin in August, 2011.

The Assistant Professor of Social Work position is a tenure track position for the university's MSW programming in **Colorado Springs, Colorado**. Responsibilities include classroom teaching, academic advising, school and community service, research, and other duties as assigned.

Candidates must have an earned doctorate in social work, a Masters degree in Social Work (MSW) from a CSWE accredited program and substantial professional practice experience. Experience teaching in either BSW or MSW programs is also required, with expertise in social policy and macro-level practice preferred. Applicants who are ABD and who anticipate completion of the degree by August, 2011 will be considered.
