Tenure Track-Assistant/Associate Professor

The Department of Social Work at Alabama A & M University (AAMU) invites applications for two tenure-track faculty positions (assistant or associate professor) with positions to begin in fall 2011 or earlier.

Situated in the northeast quadrant of the high tech center of Huntsville, a metropolitan area of approximately 500,000 residents, AAMU offers its 5,500-student population a wide range of course offerings under the schools of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, Arts and Sciences, Business, Education, and Engineering and Technology. The University is home to one of only two MSW programs in the state.

Eligible candidates must possess: (1) an MSW; (2) a minimum of two-years post-MSW practice experience; (3) an earned doctorate in social work/social welfare or a closely related field (applicants who are ABD will be considered); (4) a demonstrated commitment to excellence in teaching graduate and undergraduate students; (5) a demonstrated ability to engage diverse populations; and (6) evidence of scholarly productivity and or demonstrated potential to engage in research publications and grant development. Preference will be given to applicants with administrative experience in social work education and an interest in teaching courses in the areas of social work practice, human behavior and or social welfare policy. Specialization in child welfare and or mental health is particularly desired.

Application requirements include: letter of application, CV, three professional references, unofficial transcripts of the MSW and highest degree earned.
