

**Fayetteville State University College of Arts & Sciences

Position Announcement**

The Department of Social Work at Fayetteville State University invites applications for a tenure track Bachelor of Social Work Director position at the rank of assistant, associate, or full professor. The candidate will provide leadership in establishing a new Bachelor of Social Work Program and preparing Council on Social Work Education accreditation self-study. This is an eleven month position, which will be available August 2011. Salary is competitive and rank is contingent upon qualifications. This position will remain open until filled.

Fayetteville State University is one of the 16 universities that comprise the University of North Carolina system. The City of Fayetteville is rapidly expanding and is within range of major regional and national transportation. It has recently been recognized as one of the major areas for economic growth. Fort Bragg, the largest military installation in the United States is within ten minutes of the University. The department has a unique contractual relationship with the U S Army at Fort Sam Houston, Texas to prepare MSW trained military personnel and also a contract for the North Carolina Welfare Collaborative program to prepare MSW students for leadership roles in the field of child welfare services. Additionally, the Department has established a part-time weekend MSW Program. FSU provides a competitive salary. Priority consideration will be given to applications received on or before December 31, 2010. The faculty of the CSWE-accredited Master of Social Work program seeks a dynamic colleague committed to teaching excellence, research, and service. The position will remain open until filled.

Duties & Responsibilities: Candidates must have a Doctorate in social work or closely related field and an MSW degree and three-years post-MSW practice experience preferred. The successful candidate will demonstrate a strong research capacity and the potential to generate external research funding. In addition, the department is seeking individuals with a willingness to teach primarily in the BSW Program. Previous experience or interest with online teaching is desired. The candidate will be expected to teach, advise students, engage in scholarly activities, participate on university/college/department committees, and provide community service.

Qualifications:

The Department seeks candidates with demonstrated excellence in, enthusiasm for, and commitment to undergraduate teaching. This position requires strong organizational, interpersonal and communication skills.
