

Assistant Dean for the School of Social Work

Morgan State University invites applications for the position of Assistant Dean for the School of Social Work.

We seek candidates who have a strong desire to contribute to a thriving social work program at one of the nation's largest Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU). The program offers the BSW, MSW, and the Ph.D degrees and currently has 375 students. Both the BSW and MSW Programs are fully accredited by CSWE. Morgan's BSW Program is 40 years old but the graduate programs began in 2005/6. The overall mission of Morgan's School of Social Work is to prepare urban practitioners and leaders, policy experts, knowledge producers, scholars and social work educators who are committed to solving urban issues and problems and improving the quality of life for urban communities. Special focus is on urban children, youth and families, school social work, gerontology and public health social work within a social and economic justice framework.

Founded in 1867, and located in Baltimore, Maryland, Morgan State University is one of the nation's oldest HBCU's. Morgan's mission is to serve a multiethnic and multiracial student body and to help ensure that the benefits of higher education are enjoyed by a broad segment of the population. The university is designated as Maryland's public urban university and offers a comprehensive range of academic programs including twenty-five master's degree and fourteen doctoral programs, e.g. master's and doctorate in public health, masters in nursing, doctorates in psychometrics, business, engineering, history.

The Assistant Dean is responsible for leadership and management of day-to-day operations of the school, including fiscal operations, faculty welfare and development, staff management, curriculum review, annual reports, program and classroom logistics, implementation of strategic objectives of the school, support and development of research and grantsmanship. The Assistant Dean reports to the Dean of the School of Social Work. The Assistant Dean is expected to have achieved senior faculty rank and to have an established scholarship record. Prior academic administrative experience is a plus.

The Search Committee will begin reviewing applications and nominations immediately and will continue until positions are filled. Applicant should send a letter of application, a complete curriculum vitae, and names of three references with contact information to: Electronic submission preferred.
