Campbellsville University is hiring an Assistant/Associate Professor for the BSW program in the Carver School of Social Work & Counseling to fill a new position created due to student growth and a developing MSW program. The BSW program is fully accredited by CSWE and the MSW Program is scheduled for the initial accreditation review fall, 2011. Campbellsville University is a coeducational, Baptist affiliated university with a current student enrollment slightly over 3,600 students.

Job Description: Reports to the BSW Program Director in the Carver School of Social Work and Counseling. Selected candidate is responsible for course instruction, participating with peer faculty in the reaffirmation of accreditation process, advising students, serving as a field liaison if necessary, scholarly activity commensurate with the mission of the University, and/or maintaining service relationships with community agencies/organizations, applied research, and engaging in university and community service. A commitment to diversity and student success is essential.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Demonstrated record of excellence as an educator/scholar/practitioner in an accredited MSW/BSW program; the ability to teach in two or more of the following Social Work content areas: direct practice in social work, human behavior, policy, diversity or research; and experience in using technologies as instructional methods in the classroom. Experience and commitment to the use of technology in distance learning or a willingness to learn and deliver this mode of instruction is a must. Instructional activities will primarily occur at the Campbellsville University Louisville Kentucky location; however, an occasional course will be required on the Campbellsville campus. The qualified applicant will have an appreciation for faith based service and practice scholarship.

Minimum Qualifications: Earned Doctorate in Social Work or a closely related field from a regionally accredited institution or equivalent accreditation and a Master of Social Work degree from a CSWE accredited program. Candidate must have a minimum of 2 years of post MSW practice experience in a practice setting. ABD will be considered if degree conferred by August 2011.

Preferred Qualifications: A minimum of 2 years college/university level teaching experience in regionally accredited MSW/BSW program(s). Ideal candidates should have the ability to teach across the curriculum, but especially practice, diversity, social policy, and organization.
