Announcement of Faculty Positions

Applications are now being accepted for multiple tenure track faculty positions at the assistant, associate, or full professor level. All candidates must have an earned doctorate in social work or an appropriate social or health science discipline, ability to teach at the MSW and PhD levels; and a commitment to exemplary research, high quality scholarly publications, and preparation of fundable research proposals. A MSW, with two years of practice experience, is preferred. Applicants at the associate and full professor level must have substantial evidence of productive research and of recent receipt of extramural support. We seek, for at least one of these positions, a person with expertise working on multidisciplinary research projects. Faculty with any of the following areas of expertise are strongly encouraged to apply:

- Health, aging, behavioral health, and inter-professional practice
- Individual, family, group, organization, or community interventions
- Research with underserved populations
- Health and mental health services research
- Policy research in these areas

The University of Maryland School of Social Work (UM SSW) is located on an urban health services campus and ranks among the top 20 schools of social work in scholarly productivity and reputation. The UM SSW supports excellence in research; provides outstanding MSW, PhD, and professional education; and demonstrates commitment to the well-being of populations and communities at risk. With an enrollment of over 900 MSW students and more than 40 PhD students, the UM SSW offers a wide array of teaching opportunities.
