Advanced Clinical Social Work Fellowship

The Yale Child Study Center offers a one-year Advanced Clinical Social Work Fellowship to begin July 1st through June 30th of each year.

Social work fellows participate in both multi-disciplinary and discipline specific advanced clinical training, which includes didactics, intensive supervision, and direct practice. Previous trainings have included Parent Management Training, Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT), and Minding the Baby®, among others. Direct practice occurs in either the Outpatient Clinic or the Intensive In-home Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Services program.

Fellows are provided with a stipend of \$25,200 and free, comprehensive health care through the Yale Health Plan.

Eligible applicants must have satisfactorily completed accredited Master's level training in Social Work by the start of the training year (July 1st) for which applying. Preference is given to applicants with previous direct clinical experience.
