The Texas Transgender Nondiscrimination Summit (TTNS) Planning Committee is currently accepting proposals from universities and colleges in Texas to host the 7th Annual Texas Transgender Nondiscrimination Summit in Summer 2015. All costs involved in the Summit are covered by the TTNS. We ask that the college or university allow us access to specified rooms at no charge.

If your university or college is interested in hosting the Summit in the summer of 2015, please submit a proposal with the following minimal requirements:

- 1) A room that can hold at least 100 people
- 2) Three additional rooms that can hold approximately 35 people each
- 3) Provide a liaison from your university or college to participate in monthly telephone conference call meetings and coordinate tasks associated with facilities
