Invites applications for a Full-time Tenure-track Position

The University of Southern Indiana Social Work Department invites applicants for a tenure-track position at the assistant professor level. Responsibilities include teaching courses in the BSW and MSW Programs, advising, university service, and scholarship. An agenda of scholarly activity is also required. Preference will be given to applicants with expertise in policy, macro practice and social work administration. Interest and experience in distance education are a plus. Appointment begins fall semester 2012.

Minimum qualifications: an MSW from a CSWE accredited program with two years post-MSW employment in social work, and a doctorate in social work (or related field) from a nationally accredited institution of higher education are required.

The Social Work Department is a combined program offering a BSW in generalist practice and a MSW with a clinical concentration. Faculty members are strongly collegial, with a commitment to teaching excellence, scholarship, and service to the University and the region. The University is located in Evansville, Indiana, serving a tri-state area. The University is growing with current enrollment of 11,000 students. Review of applications will begin February 2012 and continue until a candidate has been selected.
