The position requires competence in teaching in generalist and clinical social work practice, research, behavioral and social science theory, social work theory and human behavior. The responsibilities include teaching in the graduate programs, with the opportunity to teach at the undergraduate level. The successful candidate will also be required to seek research funding and engage in scholarship and service.

The School of Social Work is one of the three schools in the College of Public Service. The School offers the B. S. W. , M. S. W. and Ph.D. programs and has a student enrollment of approximately 400 students.
