Social Work Program

East Central University (ECU), a regional four-year university located in Ada, Oklahoma, seeks an Instructor/Assistant Professor in Human Resources, tenure-track if eligible. Starting date will be August 2012 at the latest. ECU is student-centered and offers thirty-three undergraduate baccalaureate degree programs in arts and letters, business, education, mathematics and sciences, nursing, and the social sciences. Nine master's degrees are offered in education, human resources, psychology, and accounting. ECU's 4,800 students come from 38 countries and 32 different states. About 65% of the 173 faculty members hold doctorates.

The University is committed to teaching excellence and invites applications from candidates with strong records of teaching, scholarly activity, program development, and professional service. The position is located in the Department of Human Resources which includes programs in human services counseling, criminal justice, and social work. The Social Work Program has approximately 80 majors and has been fully accredited by the Council on Social Work Education since 1984.

Duties and Responsibilities: Teach across the BSW program curriculum including introductory courses in social work, Human Behavior and the Social Environment, and Research and fulfill responsibilities in student advising, recruitment, and student field placements. Teaching load is twelve semester hours and includes teaching courses at outreach sites as necessary.

Qualifications: Doctoral degree in Social Work or related field and a minimum of two years of post MSW practice experience. A minimum of a Master's degree in Social Work is required. Candidates with an MSW and minimum two years of post MSW practice experience will be considered. Teaching experience should be documented. Demonstrated interest and experience with distance and outreach program deliver, and experience with Web-based course delivery will be considered assets.
