

The University of Alaska Fairbanks' Social Work Department, a fully accredited CSWE undergraduate program, invites applications for a tenure track faculty position at the Assistant or Associate Professor level to begin August 2014. Ph.D. in Social Work or closely related field at the time of application. Applicants must also hold an M.S.W. from an accredited university.

The responsibilities of this position support the University of Alaska Fairbanks' tripartite mission of teaching, research and service. Teaching responsibilities include undergraduate courses; maintenance of an active research program leading to refereed publications; and university and community service.

Founded in 1917, the University of Alaska Fairbanks is the flagship campus of the University of Alaska System, and is the nation's northernmost Land, Sea, and Space Grant institution. It is an ethnically diverse RU/H university in a beautiful rural northern setting. Fairbanks, located in interior Alaska, is the state's second largest city with over 90,000 residents in the greater Fairbanks area. The city enjoys spectacular views of the Alaska Range and is located near the confluence of the Tanana and Chena Rivers, approximately 120 miles north of Denali National Park and 40 miles south of the White Mountains National Recreation Area. The city enjoys long sunny days during the summer months, with temperatures frequently passing the 70 degree mark. The shorter winter days make for excellent Northern Lights viewing, cross-country skiing and other winter sports. Surrounded by millions of acres of wilderness, the setting offers wildlife sightings and unparalleled outdoor recreational activities.
