Job Description	<p>This position is primarily responsible for providing the prevention and intervention foundation, support work and direct chemical dependency counseling to program participants who present with a history of current/recent past use/abuse of substances and/or alcohol. Counselor will facilitate C/D groups, one-on-one support, preventions and intervention and didactic presentations. Perform C/D assessments for new admits and create treatment plans for clients. Utilizes appropriate and evidence-based models to support individuals maintain a healthier life. This position travels between programs as well as provides services at a central location.</p> <p><u>Daily Duties and Tasks</u></p> <p>Provides training and framework regarding the effects of chemical dependency on stabilizing clients housing, medical adherence and ability to gain economic independence. Provides support to case managers when clients are in crisis. Follows a C/D curriculum on a weekly basis, subject to change as needed. Presents client intervention options in bi-weekly case staffing meetings. Prepares a C/D transition plan with client, according to client needs. Participates in bi-weekly case staffing to discuss client progress and transition planning. Meets with coordinators to review service gaps and work performance barriers. Facilitates C/D groups. Meets individually with clients a minimum of one (1) fifty-minute session each month. Reviews and discusses recovery progress with clients individually. Assigns twelve-step work to clients as appropriate. Performs C/D assessments on clients within 72 hours of admission. Creates with client Chemical Dependency Treatment plan within 72-hours of admission.</p>
