QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants should have an MSW or MSSW degree from a CSWE-accredited program, a minimum of two years of post-master's professional social work practice experience, an active Christian faith, and enthusiasm for the mission of the Baylor School of Social Work. Licensure as a social worker and a record of strong teaching experience are desired, and a Ph.D. degree or its equivalent is valued.

RESPONSIBILITIES: This position is primarily one of teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels. The position requires active involvement in the life of the faculty and school. Engagement in research projects is possible though not required for candidates seeking this opportunity.

RANK AND SALARY: Commensurate with experience and qualifications.
