



Lecturer and Field Coordinator of Social Work, non-tenure track (with benefits)

The Ohio University Lancaster Campus is seeking candidates for a part-time, renewable non-tenure track position of Lecturer and Field Coordinator of Social Work to begin January 2, 2015. The chosen applicant will be expected to teach undergraduate Social Work courses in support of the degree program. General faculty responsibilities include the ability to advise and mentor students; secure practicum and field sites for Social Work students; develop, supervise and monitor field placements, teach the field placement seminar; teach policy and practice courses and participate in related student associations. Teaching, practicum and field placement load is 24 semester hours or equivalent per academic year. It is expected that faculty will modify courses for distance learning where appropriate and may be required to teach at another Ohio University campus or center, or through distance media, as campus and program needs determine.

Minimum Qualifications

Master's in Social Work degree required from a CSWE accredited program and at least two years of post-MSW practice experience.

Preferred Qualifications

Prior college teaching experience and knowledge of the social service agencies throughout southeastern Ohio. Licensed Independent Social Worker with Supervision (LISW-S) credential in Ohio or eligible for this license.

The Ohio University Lancaster Campus is located about 25 miles south-east of Columbus and 45 miles north of the main campus in Athens. Over 2,500 traditional and nontraditional students enroll each semester in associate's, bachelor's and master's degree programs located in Lancaster or its Pickerington Center.
