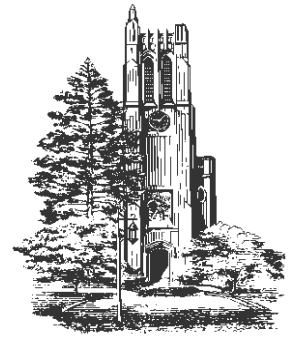

Open Rank Tenure Track Position



The Michigan State University School of Social Work in the College of Social Science is seeking applications for an Open Rank Tenure System position to complement and enhance active research areas in the School. The faculty engage in research with diverse content areas including gerontology, child welfare, and health/mental health. The research environment at MSU is one that encourages collaboration among disciplines and across colleges. We seek a colleague with an established record of funded research and scholarly publications and a clear plan for continued research activity.

MSU is a land-grant, Carnegie RU/VH, AAU, global university located in East Lansing, Michigan, near the state capital. The School is dedicated to educating students for competent, responsive, and ethical social work practice. Our teaching, research, and outreach seek to promote positive change and social justice for diverse communities, organizations, groups, families, and individuals. More than 500 students are enrolled in our CSWE-accredited BASW and MSW programs, and PhD program.

The School supports MSU's outreach mission through off-campus, distance, and blended instructional programs that utilize technology and innovative teaching strategies. We also provide multiple opportunities for creative interdisciplinary teaching and research, community-based studies, and partnerships with government agencies and neighborhoods.

Responsibilities: The successful candidate will work with faculty and students to implement the land-grant mission at MSU through the following:

- Continue an active, sustainable program of scholarship as evidenced by peer-reviewed publications and presentations
- Pursue and secure external funding from public and private sources
- Teach and mentor diverse students in the School's programs
- Participate in School, College, and University governance activities
- Add intellectual diversity and cultural richness to the School

Required Qualifications:

- An earned doctorate degree in Social Work or closely related field
- An established record of externally funded research and scholarly publications

Strongly Preferred Qualifications:

- Evidence of a strong teaching record
- Experience mentoring graduate students
- A record of outreach and service
- Demonstrated ability for administrative and research leadership

Appointment: This is a 9-month tenure track position beginning August 2015. Salary for this position is negotiable and commensurate with the candidate's qualifications and experience.
