Job Title: Assistant/Associate Professor and MSW Program Coordinator

Job Description: The University of Texas at El Paso, College of Health Sciences invites nominations and applications for the position of Assistant or Associate Professor of Social Work from talented individuals who will demonstrate excellence in research, teaching, and service. This position is a tenure-track/tenure eligible nine-month academic year appointment with the possibility of summer teaching. The appointment at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor will be commensurate with experience and qualifications. The successful candidate will serve as the Coordinator of the MSW Program with responsibility for leading an established program and have the ability to work effectively with faculty, staff, students and community stakeholders from diverse ethnic, cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds. The Coordinator will oversee the admission process, prepare the course schedule, chair the MSW Program Committee, work closely with the Field Education Coordinator to ensure appropriate and high quality MSW student placements, and ensure CSWE accreditation standards compliance. The MSW Program Coordinator reports to the Department Chair. Anticipated appointment date is Fall 2013.

Qualifications: (1) Earned doctoral degree in social work or a closely related field with, (2) at least 1 year of experience in an administrative position within the community or a university setting, (3) an established track record of academic scholarship and external fund development, (4) history of or potential to conduct a program of teaching and research on border health and welfare issues in a bi-national, bi-cultural environment, (5) MSW degree and a minimum of two years post-masters practice experience in social work, (6) participation in leadership roles in professional organizations.

Preferred Qualifications:

(1) Bilingual (English/Spanish) writing and speaking skills and experience with curriculum development and course scheduling, (2) experience with CSWE accreditation processes, (3) licensure in Texas as an LMSW or LCSW or license-eligible in Texas, (4) 3 years of teaching and mentoring in an accredited social work program in a higher education institution.
