Job Title: Tenure-Track Faculty Position

Job Description: Saint Louis University, a Catholic, Jesuit institution dedicated to student learning, research, health care, and service, is seeking applicants for a 9-month, tenure-track faculty position in the School of Social Work, beginning August 2013. The School is noted for its commitment to students, strong practice orientation, exemplary scholarship, and vision of social justice. The School of Social Work is experiencing dynamic change with new interdisciplinary offerings and research collaborations as part of a newly created College for Public Health and Social Justice. Currently, the school offers a master of social work with approximately 200 students, a baccalaureate of social work with over 100 students, a bachelor of arts in criminology and criminal justice, and three graduate offerings in Applied Behavior Analysis.

Qualifications: Candidates should possess an MSW and two years post-MSW clinical practice experience and a doctorate in social work or a closely related field. Candidates must have a strong background in research and teaching. The candidate's substantive area is open, but the ability to focus on clinical practice with families is particularly desired. A record of publications and the ability to obtain external funding also are desired. The successful applicant will be expected to engage in research and other scholarly activities, teach courses, and provide service to the school, university, and community. The candidate should be able to teach clinical social work practice courses at the graduate level. Salary and rank are dependent on qualifications and experience.
