

A full-time faculty Assistant Professor position in the Social Work program is available at Nebraska Wesleyan University beginning August 2014. This is a 9 month position, with a three year contingency contract.

Qualifications: A MSW degree from a CSWE-accredited program with at least four years of post-Masters social work experience needed. Doctorate in social work or closely related discipline is desirable. The primary focus is on generalist social work practice for this dynamic and growing CSWE-accredited BSW program with both day and evening programs and campuses in Lincoln and Omaha, Nebraska. The applicant should have demonstrated teaching expertise in generalist social work courses. Possible areas of teaching in the social work curriculum may include: social policy, human behavior and the social environment, and macro practice. Opportunities exist to teach courses in area of applicant's specialization. Applicants should be interested in working with both traditional and non-traditional student populations. Familiarity with Blackboard course technology is a plus. History of engaged involvement with NASW is preferred. Excellent interpersonal and teaching skills required. Ability to work independently and collaboratively with faculty and students is essential. A valid driver's license and access to transportation are required.

Responsibilities: Teaching load is four courses in a traditional semester which may also consist of eight- week sessions with courses delivered in an accelerated, evening format. The successful applicant will report to the Chair of the Social Work Department. NWU is a liberal arts university whose faculty is expected to excel at teaching and be active in both scholarship and service.
