Job Description	To run the newly created Norse Violence Prevention Center. This grant-funded position will work with social work and counseling faculty and staff, the Dean of Students staff, University Police, and other appropriate NKU departments and external agencies such as the Highland Heights Police Department and Women's Crisis Center. Responsibilities will include developing and implementing policies regarding violence against women; training campus constituents; developing and implementing education programs geared towards NKU students for the prevention of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence and stalking; and developing, strengthening, and providing victim's advocacy services. This will be geared to all students on the NKU campus, with special emphasis on the LGBTQ and veteran populations.

Knowledge of student development theory and practice. Familiarity with university administrative practices and procedures. Excellent interpersonal, oral and written communication skills.
