Job Description	The Youth Service Specialist provides early intervention, prevention and case management services for "at risk" students in the school district. The Youth Service Specialist works with youth and families in crisis situations. This is a school-based service and the successful candidate will address the social, economic and academic needs of students experiencing school behavior problems, parent/child conflicts, runaway, truancy, medical issues, basic needs, etc. Community Youth Services is a free, voluntary program that accepts referrals from any source and seeks to resolve issues at the earliest possible level and in the least stigmatizing way. Position is in a fast-paced environment that involves collaboration with schools and other agencies.
Qualifications	Bachelor's Degree is required. Bachelor's or Master's Degree majoring in psychology, sociology, social work, criminal justice or closely related field is preferred. EXPERIENCE: Must have one (1) year full-time paid experience in a youth-service agency.
