

Social Work Assistant/Associate Professor Position Available

Eastern Kentucky University invites applications for a full-time tenure-track position in social work in the Department of Anthropology, Sociology, and Social Work. Applications will be accepted at the assistant or associate professor rank. We seek a social worker with experience in practice, policy, and university teaching. MSW and a minimum of five years practice experience required; doctorate from a regionally accredited (SACS, etc) or internationally recognized institution is required for tenure and promotion. We also seek an individual with a strong record of and commitment to teaching undergraduate majors (a 4/4 teaching load). Preference given to applicants with experience teaching social policy and macro practice, and that have a strong scholarly agenda and record, a sensitivity to rural and regional needs, and dedication to active community outreach. Position requires teaching at regional campus locations as part of a regular rotation cycle. Candidates are invited to discuss their proficiency with online teaching in their letter of application.

Review of applications is ongoing until the position is filled. The position begins August 15, 2014.
