Job Description	<p>Designed as a problem-solving court, the Harris County Felony Mental Health Court (FMHC) is a voluntary program for defendants who have been diagnosed with a mental illness and charged with a felony offense. The FMHC is a collaborative partnership between the criminal justice system, a network of community-based providers and the defendant. The ultimate goal of the FMHC is to ensure public safety and minimize recidivism while diverting defendants with a mental illness from incarceration and instead facilitating linkage to appropriate treatment and community resources.</p> <p>The FMHC Case Manager will be responsible for assessing the nature and degree of the FMHC participant service needs and subsequently developing, implementing, monitoring and adjusting the FMHC Re-Entry Plan. This position reports directly to the FMHC Clinical Supervisor.</p>
