The School of Social Welfare at the University of California, Berkeley is recruiting a post-doctoral scholar in association with the Mack Center on Mental Health and Social Conflict, run by Professor Steven P. Segal, with a start date of September 1, 2012.

To qualify for the position, applicants must have completed their doctoral dissertations in social work or a related field by the start date of **September 1, 2012**. While experience with mental health research and practice as well as social conflict issues are important, analytic ability, writing and quantitative research skills are required. The salary range for this 12-month position is \$45,024-\$56,856 plus benefits, depending on years of research experience. The initial appointment is for a year and may be extended for a second year.

The deadline for submitting applications is **March 30, 2012**. Appointment is contingent on funding availability. Candidates should submit the following: 1) a cover letter related to mental health services research experience, 2) a current resume, 3) a writing sample, and 4) a list of three references.
