



Visiting Assistant Professor in Social Work

The Department of Social Work of Saint Mary's College, Notre Dame, IN, a Catholic, four-year women's college, is seeking to fill a visiting assistant professor position in Social Work for the 2012-2013 academic year. Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate Social Work courses in the curriculum areas of human behavior and the social environment, introduction to social work, social work practice with individuals and groups, and mental health. Faculty also provide academic advising to students.

Qualifications include a M.S.W. from a CSWE-accredited program and two (2) years of post-M.S.W. practice experience. A doctorate or ABD in social work or a closely related field is preferred.
